ANNEX 1 - IFRA CATEGORY APPLICATION EXAMPLES

IFRA Category	Product Type / Application Examples
1	Lip products of all types; children's toys.
2	Deodorant and antiperspirant products; body sprays/body mist.
3	Eye products; facial make-up/foundation; make-up remover; facial masks; wipes for face, neck, hands or body.
4	Fine fragrance products such as Eau de Toilette, Parfum, Cologne, solid perfume and fragranting cream; aftershaves.
5A	Body creams, oils and lotions; foot care products; skin-applied insect repellent; powders and talc excluding baby products.
5B	Facial toner; facial moisturizers and creams, including beard and mustache care products.
5C	Hand cream; nail care products; hand sanitizers.
5D	Baby cream/lotion, baby oil, baby powders and talc.
6	Toothpaste; mouthwash; breath sprays; toothpowder and oral strips/tablets.
7A	Rinse-off hair permanent/chemical treatments, including rinse-off hair dyes.
7B	Hair sprays; styling aids; leave-on conditioners and chemical treatments; dry shampoo; hair deodorizer/perfume.
8	Intimate wipes and deodorant sprays; tampons; baby wipes; wet toilet paper.
9	Bar soap; shampoo; rinse-off facial cleansers and conditioners; liquid soap; body wash/shower gel; bath products; shaving products; depilatories.
10A	Hand-wash laundry and dish detergents; hard-surface cleaners; certain laundry products; fabric softeners; reed diffusers and related household products.
10B	Animal sprays; manual/aerosol air freshener sprays; aerosol/spray insecticides.
11A	Feminine hygiene pads/liners; baby diapers; incontinence products; dry toilet paper.
11B	Scented textiles and dry tissues; napkins; pillow spray; paper towels; certain masks and solid fertilizers.
12	Candles; machine laundry products with minimal skin contact; automated air fresheners; incense; cat litter; dryer sheets; machine dishwashing products and other non-skin-contact fragranced products.
