Section 4: First Aid Measures

Eye Contact

Immediately rinse with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.

Skin Contact

Wash thoroughly with water. Discontinue use if irritation develops.

Inhalation

Move to fresh air if respiratory irritation occurs.

Ingestion

Rinse mouth with water. Do not induce vomiting. Seek medical attention if significant quantities are swallowed.
